### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. The Dick Pierce Business Scholarship is available for students currently enrolled in college as a full time student or for High School Seniors planning to attend college.
2. Applicants **must be majoring in Business or a related field.** (Enclose most recent transcript)
3. The applicant **must be a member in good standing** with BMI Federal Credit Union.
4. Previous winners of the Dick Pierce Business Scholarship are not eligible.

### ESSAY REQUIREMENTS

- a. Must include a title page containing the following information
  - Essay Title, Student's Name, Student's Address and Phone Number
- b. Your essay must be typed in 12-point size type and double spaced on 8-1/2" x 11" white paper with one-inch margins on all sides. The text of your essay should be no more than three pages excluding title page.

### SELECTION CRITERIA

The Selection Committee will base the selection of the scholarship recipients on the following:

#### 1. Application: (35 points)

- Community service, volunteer work, and/or extracurricular activities. (1-10 points)
- Honors, awards, recognitions and/or leadership achievements (1-10 points)
- Education/career goals and how scholarship will help you in obtaining these goals (1-10 points)
- Compliance with required format (1-5 points)

#### 2. Essay: (65 points)

- Quality of essay (1 - 50 points)
- Grammar, punctuation, spelling and neatness for print (1-10 points)
- Compliance with required format (1-5 points)
